## **Prep Instructions for Colonoscopy**

1 WEEK PRIOR TO PROCEDURE:
☐ Stop taking any Iron supplements
Avoid eating popcorn, corn, nuts, seeds and fruits with small seeds
3 DAYS PRIOR TO PROCEDURE:
<ul> <li>Stop Coumadin, Plavix or other blood thinner as directed by your primary care physician or specialist</li> </ul>
THE DAY PRIOR TO PROCEDURE:
<ul> <li>Breakfast only: You may have 2 slices of toast (white bread only) with only</li> </ul>
butter/margarine. You may also have fried eggs or rice with butter/margarine.
□ NO OTHER SOLID FOODS after this point. However, you may have things such as plair white milk, plain vanilla ice cream, and plain vanilla pudding until 6 pm. You may also have coffee, tea, clear broth, jello, clear fruit juices without pulp (such as white grape or
apple), 7-up, popsicles, Crystal Light, or Kool-Aid until midnight.
☐ Do NOT drink anything RED or PURPLE. Do not drink alcohol.
<ul> <li>SUPREP: FIRST DOSE - See reverse side for instructions.</li> </ul>
☐ Drink ALL of the Suprep, even if your stool is clear or yellow. If your colon is not clean,
your doctor may not be able to complete your colonoscopy.
☐ NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT
THE MORNING OF THE PROCEDURE
☐ Nothing to eat or drink except the Suprep.
□ SUPREP: SECOND DOSE - See reverse side for instructions.
☐ All Prescribed medications should be taken with a sip of water; these will not affect the
prep. (Do not take Coumadin, Plavix, or ASA).
Insulin dose should be ½ the dose. DO NOT take oral diabetic medication; bring this
along with you to take after the procedure.
You MUST have a responsible adult accompany you and drive you home following the
procedure due to the medications given during the procedure.

### On the day before your procedure...

What You CAN do:

You may have a light breakfast or have clear liquids ONLY; please have nothing for dinner

#### What You CANNOT do:

- DO NOT drink milk
- **DO NOT** eat or drink anything colored red or purple
- DO NOT drink alcoholic beverages

#### Any of the following liquids are OK to drink.

- Water
- Strained fruit juices (without pulp) including apple, orange, white grape, or white cranberry
- Limeade or lemonade
- Coffee or tea (DO NOT use any dairy or non-dairy creamer)
- Chicken broth
- Gelatin desserts without added fruit or topping (NO RED OR PURPLE)

#### Note:

- SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit is indicated for cleansing of the colon as a preparation for colonoscopy in adults
- Be sure to tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and non-prescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit may affect how other medicines work
- Medication taken by mouth may not be absorbed properly when taken within 1 hour before the start of each dose of SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit
- The most common adverse reactions after administration of SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit were overall discomfort, abdominal distention, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, and headache


SUPREP Bowel Prep Kit is a split-dose (2-day) regimen. Both 6-ounce bottles are required for a complete prep.

FIRST DOSE: Begin Step 1 at PM the evening before your procedure and proceed as shown below:

You must complete Steps 1 through 4 using one (1) 6-ounce bottle before going to bed:



Pour ONE (1) 6-ounce bottle of SUPREP liquid into the mixing container.



Add cool drinking water to the 16-ounce line on the container and mix.

**NOTE:** Dilute the solution concentrate as directed prior to use.



Drink ALL the liquid in the container.

# STEP 4 **IMPORTANT**

You **must** drink two (2) more 16-ounce containers of water over the next 1 hour.

SECOND DOSE: Begin Step 1 at AM the morning of your procedure and proceed as shown above:

For this dose, repeat Steps 1 through 4 shown above using the other 6-ounce bottle.

**NOTE:** You **must** finish drinking the final glass of water at least 2 hours. or as directed, before your colonoscopy.

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
